



Career Landscape

Goal: Assess student's current understanding of the careers available to them, create a baseline shared understanding upon which to build, tease out questions and perceptions about various careers.

Lesson Duration (60-75 mins)

Intro (15 mins)

Breathing Exercise (2 mins)

(Students are encouraged to reflect on the past lessons as they breath.)

Class Discussion Jobs and Industries

"Today, we're going to explore the breadth of careers that are available to all of you"

- Students must distinguish between Industries and Jobs.

Example

Career Field: *Education*

Job: *Teacher, Principal, Teacher, Administrator, Educational Non-Profit Director*

Career Field: *Healthcare*

Job: *Doctor, Nurse Practitioner, Home Aide*

- Hand out Job/Industry List.

Prompts for the Lists

"Are there careers/industries on this sheet that none of you have ever seen/heard of?"

"If so, which ones are they?"

"Are there any careers here that you think you might be interested in?"

"If so, which ones are they?"

- Students write down 5-10 new jobs/industries on the list that they've never seen but are interested in.

Creative Exercise-Web & Collage (40 mins)

Web Activity

- Break Students up into small groups.
- Students are given cut out pieces of paper with various jobs/industries.
- Students create a web/map of jobs/industries based on how they understand them to relate. The result should be a web of arrows/words/symbols and drawings that connect the different jobs and industries as understood by the students.
- Students will then be encouraged to share out their maps in groups. Those who wish to share in front of the entire class will be given time in the end.

Wrap-Up & Reflection (10-15 Mins)

Name one thing you learned?
